*Distribution Network to Include Territories in Denmark, Sweden, Norway,

June 17, 2008: Fisker Automotive, Inc., a green American premium car company, today announced Nellemann Holding AS as its newest International importer and distributor with territories to include Denmark, Sweden, Norway, Greenland and the Faeroe Islands. This announcement comes fresh on the heels of the recent appointment of Fisker Italia as the first International importer. With plans to eventually allocate more than 50 percent of its production to overseas sales, Fisker Automotive is poised to become a leading exporter of premium US automobiles.
