



The Crown Prince of Denmark, HRH Frederik, will tomorrow travel to the COP15 UN Climate Conference events in Copenhagen with the Fisker Karma plug-in hybrid car.

HRH Frederik will visit at 4 pm Copenhagen event at Raadhuspladsen after which he will leave in the Fisker Karma at 5 pm to the Bella Center.

The prototype saloon, developed by American automaker Fisker Automotive, can travel 80km (50mi) emission-free on a single charge of its Lithium-ion battery, and an additional 400km (250mi) on a range extending generator turned by an efficient fourcylinder gas engine. Economy is 2.4L/100km and emissions of just 83g/km CO<sub>2</sub> – better than today's best hybrids. Still, the Karma can reach 100km/h (62mph) in about 6 seconds and exceed 200km/h (125mph).
